Attire

Casual, cool attire – including golf and tennis wear – is appropriate for breakfast and lunch. Suggested attire for dinner ranges from resort wear to business casual. Proper attire for golf is a shirt with a collar and slacks or Bermuda-length dress shorts for men. Proper attire for ladies is a shirt with a collar, slacks or dress shorts, and any fashion that is considered golf attire. No blue jeans allowed on golf course.

Children will be comfortable in loose-fitting clothes or bathing suits during their camp program.

Groceries

Please check your pre-arrival package and email for information on pre-ordering groceries. Pre-ordered groceries will be delivered to your cottage on Saturday.

Transportation

You will need a car, bicycle or rental golf cart in order to reach all areas while you are at Callaway Gardens. Bikes are a great way to get around the Gardens – our Discovery Bicycle Trail will lead you almost everywhere you want to go. You may bring your own bikes or rent them here. There is no shuttle between attractions.

Summer Family Adventure guests may charge bicycle rentals to their room account.

Guests are responsible for all damage to and/or theft of bikes. Charges for bikes not returned are \$500 for Trek FX, \$400 for 3-speed Automatic, 3-speed Manual Shift and Trail-A-Bike, and \$300 for 20"/24" Kids, 6-speed and child carrier.

Georgia state law requires bicycle helmets for all riders ages 16 and under. All rented helmets require a \$5 refundable deposit.
