## GARDENS SPOTLIGHT

As you travel through the Gardens, watch for:

**Sasanqua Camellias:** *Camellia sasanqua*, found on the Meadowlark Trail, these shrubs have pink, purple, and white flowers.

**Winterberry Holly:** *Ilex verticillata*, bright red berries along the stems add color to the landscape and attract birds to feast on the ripening fruit. This deciduous shrub will soon lose its foliage so the berries will even be more prominent.

**Golden Rod:** *Solidago sp.*, masses of yellow flowers in the Entry Meadow and in Native Areas.

**Devil’s Walking Stick:** *Aralia spinosa*, commonly known as Devil’s Walking stick, is a woody species of plants in the genus Aralia, family Araliaceae, native to eastern North America.

**Native Butterfly Gardens:** Located around the outside of the Day Butterfly Center, learn what plants will attract butterflies, humming birds, and other pollinators and see Georgia’s native Autumn butterflies as well as their caterpillars.

**Monarch Migration:** Each year, millions of monarchs migrate from Canada to Mexico – a 2,000+ mile journey – and their route takes them right through Georgia! Look for these iconic and beautiful orange and black butterflies outside the Day Butterfly Center as they use our Native Butterfly Gardens as a pit stop along their incredible journey.
