GARDENS SPOTLIGHT

As you travel through the Gardens, watch for:

Limelight Hydrangea: (*Hydrangea Garden Trail, Mountain Creek Inn*) A deciduous shrub with white conical heads can be found throughout the Gardens.

American Beautyberry: Clusters of bright purple fruit are displayed along the stems of this deciduous shrub.

Loblolly Bay: (Hummingbird Lake) Loblolly Bay is a fairly common medium-sized evergreen tree of moist (but not wet) areas of the with upright form and spectacular white fragrant Camellia-like flowers in summer. Like Camellia, Gordonia is in the tea family.

Plumleaf Azalea: *Rhododendron prunifolium*, the plumleaf azalea, is a wild azalea that grows only in a few counties along the Georgia–Alabama border in the Chattahoochee River Valley. It is considered the rarest azalea in the Eastern United States.

Surprise Lilies: Red spidery flowers top the bare stems of this seasonal beauty.

Devil's Walking Stick: *Aralia spinosa*, commonly known as Devil's Walking stick, is a woody species of plants in the genus *Aralia*, family *Araliaceae*, native to eastern North America.
