What's Biting Report: December 2018

Santa has delivered Callaway Outdoors an early Christmas present. He has delivered us two lakes full of **Rainbow trout**.

Bass fishing is fair. Largemouth are suspended in the middle of the our major coves on the lake especially the coves that have the wind blowing into them. Vertical jigging with a 1/2 ounce to 3/4 ounce spoon can be productive. You might also be productive using a Shad Rap or crank bait. Drop small spoons or drag dark jigs on the bottom in deeper waters, pick them up and drop them about 5 inches at a time. You may also try fishing the structure off the ledges or points, but you'll need to put the bait directly in front the fish. All our fish seem to be ready to move to their wintertime locations and take up their wintertime feeding habits. So, it's time to get your hooks extra sharp, because you may only get one chance per cast to land one of these elusive largemouth.
