WHAT'S IN BLOOM

The **Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Trail** is the perfect spot for a Spring stroll:

Trout Lily: This flower gets its name from its fleshy, mottled leaves that resemble a trout.

Blood Root: Native to the Southeast, the sap from this flower was used by Native Americans for dye.

Common Blue Violet: This unique Spring bloomer serves as an early source for pollinators.

Toadshade, (*Trillium sp.*): This woodland perennial wildflower gets its name from "tri" referring to its flower parts which are in threes and "lium" or the funnel shape of the flower.

Dogwood: This native understory tree features large white "petals" (a form of leaf known as bracts) surrounding tiny, yellow-green flowers. *Scenic Drive, all nature trails*

Japanese Magnolia: These bright white or purple flowers remind us that Spring is close at hand. *Gardens Restaurant and Meadowlark Gardens*
