## WHAT'S IN BLOOM

Many of our famous azaleas are still in bloom. Both **Overlook Gardens** and **Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl** have descended from peak bloom, but make sure to check out the beautiful native azaleas throughout the Gardens.

As you travel through Callaway Gardens, be on the lookout for these Spring bloomers:

**Dogwood:** This native understory tree features large white "petals" (a form of leaf known as bracts) surrounding tiny, yellow-green flowers. *Scenic Drive, all nature trails*

**Japanese Magnolia:** These bright white or purple flowers remind us that Spring is close. *Gardens Restaurant and Meadowlark Gardens*

**Exotic & Native Azaleas:** These airy, open shrubs, which begin showing color in mid-March, reach heights of 15 feet. Some also have a wonderfully sweet fragrance. Florida Azaleas and Encore Azaleas are showing their full color. *Discovery Center & Information Center.*

**Pansies:** Bright faces of pansies, which come in lots of colors, add pops of color to early Spring gardens. *Throughout the Gardens*

**Woodland Phlox:** Beautiful clusters of sky-blue flowers waving in the wind. *Wildflower Trail and some places along the Scenic Drive*

**Mountain Laurel:** Blooming in Spring and Summer, it has nice attractive flowers as well as evergreen foliage. *Overlook Gardens*

**Snapdragons:** The flower is an annual bedding plant that can serve as an early Spring bloomer. *Day Butterfly Center*

**Rhododendrons:** are a late Spring bloomer that have larger showy blooms and are an evergreen shrub. *Rhododendron Trail*

**Southern Black Haw:** this large shrub blooms brilliant white and is a native to the Southeastern United States. *Backyard Wildlife Habitat-Discovery Center*

**Blue-Eyed Grass:** a low growing perennial which blooms small blue flowers. This plant performs best in woodland gardens or pine lands. *Outside Day Butterfly Center*

**Blue Water Iris:** a water-loving iris that does best planted near streams or ponds. These Irises attract hummingbirds. *Chapel Entrance*
