As you travel through the Gardens, be sure to watch for:

WHAT'S IN BLOOM

Hydrangeas: (*Hydrangea Garden Trail, Mountain Creek Inn*) A deciduous shrub with white conical heads can be found throughout the Gardens.

American Beautyberry: Clusters of bright purple fruit are displayed along the stems of this deciduous shrub.

Plumleaf Azalea: *Rhododendron prunifolium*, the plumleaf azalea, is a wild azalea that grows only in a few counties along the Georgia-Alabama border in the Chattahoochee River Valley. It is considered the rarest azalea in the Eastern United States.

Surprise Lilies: Red spidery flowers top the bare stems of this seasonal beauty.

Devil's Walking Stick: *Aralia spinosa*, commonly known as Devil's Walking stick, is a woody species of plants in the genus Aralia, family Araliaceae, native to eastern North America.

Joe Pye Weed: a native perennial plant that does best in the clay soils of the southeast. It's bright red/purple blooms are attractive to several pollinators

Native Butterfly Gardens: Located around the outside of the Day Butterfly Center, learn what plants will attract butterflies, humming birds, and other pollinators and see Georgia's native Autumn butterflies as well as their caterpillars.
