

April Bloom and Color Guide

Mayapple; (*Podophyllum peltatum*); Flower; Herbaceous perennial; native to eastern US and southeastern Canada; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl and Wildflower Trail



Jack-in-the-pulpit; (*Arisaema triphyllum*); Fruit; Herbaceous perennial; Native to eastern US; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl and the Wildflower Trail



Eastern Redbud; (*Cercis canadensis*); Flower; Large deciduous shrub or small tree; Native to eastern North America and southern Ontario; Located at Discovery Center and throughout the Gardens



Red Maple; (*Acer rubrum*); Foliage; Deciduous tree; Native to eastern and central North America; Located at Overlook and throughout the Gardens



Ornamental Mustard; (*Brassica juncea*); Foliage; Annual; Native to western coastal Europe; Located at Day Butterfly Center



Ornamental Kale; (*Brassica oleracea*); Foliage; Annual; Native to western coastal Europe; Located at Day Butterfly and Discovery Center



Yellow Lady Banks Climbing Rose; (*Rosa banksiae 'Lutea'*); Flower; Evergreen Vine; Native to central and western China; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl and the entryway of the Gardens restaurant



Wild Ginger; (*Hexastylis arifolia*); Flower; Herbaceous evergreen perennial; Native to southeastern North America; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl, Overlook and Meadowlark Garden, Rhododendron, Hydrangea and Wildflower Trail



Florida Anise; (*Illicium floridanum*); Fruit; Evergreen shrub; Native to Florida; Located at Discovery Center, Wildflower Trail, Chapel and Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl



Piedmont Azalea; (*Rhododendron canescens*); Flower; Shrub; Native to Georgia and South Carolina; Located throughout the Gardens



Trillium; (*Trillium spp.*); Flower; Perennial; Native to temperate regions of North America and Asia; Located at Wildflower Trail



Fringe Tree; (*Chionanthus virginicus*); Flower; Deciduous tree or shrub; Native to eastern US; Located at Meadowlark Garden, Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl, Chapel, Discovery Center and Rhododendron Trail



Flowering Dogwood; (*Cornus florida*); Flower; Tree; Native to eastern North America; Located throughout the Gardens



Columbine; (*Aquilegia canadensis*); Flower; Perennial; Native to meadows, woodlands and higher altitudes throughout the Northern Hemisphere; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl and Wildflower Trail



Azaleas; (*Rhododendron spp.*); Flower; Shrubs; Native to Asia, Europe and North America; Located at Mountain Creek Inn, Overlook Garden, Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl and Rhododendron Trail



Rain Lily; (*Zephyranthes atamasca*); Flower; Perennial; Native to the Western Hemisphere; Located along the drive to the Chapel, Snowflake Valley, Wildflower Trail and Meadowlark Garden



Foam Flower; (*Tiarella cordifolia*); Flower; Herbaceous perennial; Native to Nova Scotia, Appalachian Mountains to Alabama West to Minnesota; Located at Wildflower Trail



Blue Phlox; (*Phlox divaricate*); Flower; Semi-evergreen perennial; Native to forests and fields in eastern North America; Located at Meadowlark Garden and Wildflower Trail



Florida Azalea; (*Rhododendron austrinum*); Flower; Deciduous shrub; Native to Georgia & Florida; Located at Callaway Brothers Azalea Bowl, Wildflower Trail, Chapel and throughout the Gardens
